5. Transfer of personal data to a third country

3. Purposes and legal bases of processing

Purposes of processing:

Your personal data is collected for:

- **Performance of a contract**
- **Correspondence**
- **Invoicing/administration**
- **Inclusion in a database of suppliers and business partners**
- **Planning, completion and documentation of audits**
- **Documentation of compliance with the requirements to accreditation bodies, authorities, standard institutions and customers and to enable verification.**

6. Retention period for personal data

After collection, your data will be stored by the controller for as long as is necessary for completion of the specific task, taking into account the statutory retention periods in accordance with Sec. 257 Commercial Code (HGB); Sec. 147 Fiscal Code (AO).

Legal bases of processing for suppliers:

Processing for the performance of contracts pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 point b) GDPR
Processing on the basis of a legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 point f) GDPR

7. Rights of the data subject

You have the following rights according to the General Data Protection Regulation:

Where your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information from the controller about the data stored concerning you (Art. 15 GDPR).

Where inaccurate personal data is processed, you have a right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR).

Where the legal requirements are satisfied, you may obtain erasure or restriction of processing and may object to processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR).

Where you have consented to data processing or a data processing agreement exists and the data processing is carried out with the help of automated procedures, you may have a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).

4. Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

Your personal data is transferred to:

You also have the right to lodge a complain with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR).
